Advent Reading- Peace

Today we light the candle of peace.

Isaiah 9:6-7 says, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of His government and peace there will be no end."

Jesus is sent by the Father to bring peace between God and man. We are caught up in struggle, strife, and sin. Jesus doesn't just come, however, to smooth over our conflicts. Nor does He come with armed might to force us to lay down our arms. Rather, He comes to die for the sins that lie at the heart of our rebellion against Him.

The Prince of Peace takes upon Himself our sins and unrest. As Isaiah put it, "Surely He took up our pain and bore our suffering... He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed."

-Isaiah 53:4-5

To receive Christ's peace this Christmas, come to Him in surrender and, through this act of faith, receive His gift of forgiveness and grace.

"Father, forgive us our selfish, rebellious hearts. We open ourselves to you, and invite you to come into us afresh and grant us your peace. In Jesus' name we pray." Amen.
